


Judy - Block 3



All of the blocks in the Christmas Town Sampler should finish at 12".

Because so many are using so many different fabrics, instead of saying "Fabric 1" or "Fabric 2", I'll just say "where I used blue . . ." and you can make any adjustments to fabric placement that you desire.

Cutting Instructions:

Where I used **Ecru**:

Cut 6 - 3-1/4" squares. Cut each on the diagonal once to yield 12 triangles.

Cut 2 - 4-1/2" squares. Cut each on the diagonal once to yield 4 triangles.

Where I used **Purple**:

Cut 1 - 3-5/8" square. Cut on the diagonal twice to yield 4 triangles.

Cut 4 - 1-3/4" x 7" rectangles.

Where I used **Brown**:

Cut 2 - 3-1/4" squares. Cut each on the diagonal once to yield 4 triangles.


Where I used **Blue**:

Cut 1 - 1-3/4" square.


Where I used **Green**:

Cut 4 - 2-1/4" x 7-1/4" rectangles.

Construction:



Using the smaller **Ecru** triangle and the **Brown** triangles, make 4 half square triangles. Sew the remaining smaller **Ecru** triangles to the half square triangle as shown. Make 4.



Sew the larger **Ecru** triangles to each side of a **Purple** rectangle as shown. Match up the triangle edges to the end of the Purple rectangle (see arrow). The **Purple** rectangle is longer and will need to be trimmed to the point.

To trim to a point, make a mark down the center of the purple strip. Using a ruler, trim the end. See photo below.

Sew the remaining two Purple rectangles to the ends of the Blue square. The Purple rectangles are longer than needed but can be trimmed when added to the triangles made in the previous step




Sew the **Ecru/Purple** triangle section to the top and bottom of the **Purple/Blue** section, Trim the ends of the **Purple** rectangles so they're at a point.

Sew a **Green** rectangle to two opposite ends of the center.

Sew a **Purple** triangle to both ends of the two remaining **Green** rectangles.



Sew the **Green/Purple** section from above to the remaining two sides of the center.



Sew the **Brown/Ecru** triangle units to the four corners to square up the block.
