Big & Bright - 65" x 82-1/2"

16" finished blocks 12 blocks are needed

Background - 2-1/8 yards Navy Blue - 3 yards Red - 1/2 yard Gold - 1-1/4 yards



Construction:

- 1. Nine patches are made from strips cut 1-7/8". They will be 4" finished/4-1/2" unfinished. Make 6 with red/background and 6 with red/gold. Once they're made, trim them to 4-1/2". They will be a bit oversized.
- 2. Using your favorite method for flying geese, make the following which will measure $2" \times 4"$ finished or $2-1/2" \times 4-1/2"$ unfinished.

Flying Geese:

- Gold/Navy 24
- Background/Navy 120
- 3. From background fabric, cut 48 4-1/2" squares.
- 4. From navy fabric, cut:
 - 48 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
 - 96 2-1/2" squares.
- 5. From red, cut 48 2-1/2" squares.

- 6. For the sashing, from the gold fabric, cut 17 rectangles that are $2" \times 16-1/2"$.
- 7. For the sashing squares, from the red fabric, cut 6 2" squares.
- 8. Sew the blocks together, three rows of four blocks each, with a sashing piece in between each block. positioned according to the drawing on page 1.
- 9. Sew the gold sashing strips together with the2" red squares to make the sashing rows.
- 10. Sew the block rows and the sashing rows together as shown in the diagram on page 1.

Once the blocks are sewn together, the top should measure 51-1/2" x 69", including seam allowances.
